



Publication options for the scientific production presented at the ISBTS 2015

Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to inform you that there will be several opportunities to publish the product of your scientific work presented at the ISBTS 2015.

The **American Journal of Transplantation** (IF: 6.19) is willing to evaluate manuscripts following the regular submission and review process. Those that are accepted will be published together in a single volume of AJT. We encourage the works selected as Best Abstracts to be submitted there.

The American Journal of Transplantation has offered to publish a meeting report, and a Summary Report of the Workshop groups. This will be prepared by the meeting and workshop organizers.

The **Transplantation** Journal (IF: 3.53) will publish all of the accepted abstracts in electronic format. Transplantation is also willing to review manuscripts through the regular submission and editorial process.

Transplantation Proceedings (IF: 0.98) has offered to accept all other manuscripts using the following guidelines:

1. The Proceedings will offer each presenter (oral and Poster) the opportunity to submit a manuscript via the electronic portal, EES (<http://ees.elsevier.com/transproc>), by selecting Article Type ISBTS 2015. To meet stipulated timelines, all submissions must be received before August 1, 2015.
2. Following review (and revision as necessary), manuscripts will be aggregated into the Conference Proceedings for printing. If the final accepted Congress submission includes at least 500 manuscript pages, they will appear as a separate issue published in either October or November 2015.
3. In addition, after copy editing each accepted submission will be immediately released to the Internet.
4. Authors who wish to provide a video in conjunction with their manuscripts will have it appended and available upon internet release. Each video should accompany a manuscript which describes its content. There is no additional charge for the video.
5. The Society will be granted 20% of the total pages as complimentary to be allocated by the Organizing Committee. Individual authors will be expected to cover their own page charges as per journal policy.

We encourage orals, mini-orals and poster-accepted abstracts to be submitted in TP.

For those abstracts focused on Nutritional Support or Rehabilitation we have contacted the **JPEN (Journal of Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition)** (IF: 3.14), which has offered to evaluate manuscripts following the regular submission and review process. Those that are accepted will be published together in a single volume or as part of one volume depending on the number of submissions. We encourage the non-transplant related works to be submitted there.

Publications are the final result of every research and the quality and impact of a meeting will be measured by the numbers of publications that result from the abstracts presented, therefore we aim to encourage our colleagues and young faculty not to finish their research work only with an abstract presentation, but with a full paper publication.
